	 Morrison Hershfield (MH) for building envelope and roofing Read Jones Christoffersen Ltd. (RJC) for traffic membrane replacements including parking structure related projects 	
Contract Term and Estimated Contract Value:	The recommended term of the contract is 3 years, with the option to extend for 2 additional 1-year terms.

- e) The Chief Procurement Officer and General Manager, Real Estate and Facilities Management to be authorized to execute and deliver all legal documents on behalf of the City.
- f) The Bid Committee approval is pre-contract award, the final contract information may vary subject to final negotiations and award.
